"FCC R&R # § 97.23 **Mailing address.** Each license grant must show the grantee's correct name and mailing address. The mailing address must be in an area where the amateur service is regulated by the FCC and where the grantee can receive mail delivery by the United States Postal Service. Revocation of the station license or suspension of the operator license may result when correspondence from the FCC is returned as undeliverable because the grantee failed to provide the correct mailing address.

Paragraph 97.23 states that if they (FCC) cannot reach you by USPS, your license could be cancelled.
